Important information

Due to Covid-19 & keeping in line with Government guidelines we have made some changes at The Crown Country Inn. This is also for the comfort and safety of our customers & staff.

Face Masks

- Before entering, exiting, going to the toilet, or walking around you must wear a mask. Basically, unless you are sitting down you must wear a mask!_As before all our staff will still be wearing face coverings..you are not alone!
- **EXEMPTIONS:** Children under 11 years old **DO NOT** have to wear a mask. Also, if you have been exempted for health reasons, we will have to see your exemption card. Please don't be offended that we have to check.

Bookings and Table Service Only

- All tables must be pre-booked before arriving. Unfortunately with the climate as it is and no shows that do and have occurred in the past, we will be taking card details over the phone to confirm the reservation. Please see our website for further details.
- We will continue to offer full table service throughout, please be patient with all our staff when we are busy. Table service may be slower and more difficult for our staff than bar service.
- Please note that this means that all guests should remain seated at their table throughout their visit, other than for visiting the toilet etc.

PLEASE BE AWARE - If your table does not turn up or does not give 24 hours notice of cancelling a booking an automatic non refundable £15 per person charge will be made on the card that was left by the host who made the reservation.

Rule of Six Reminder (Unless government guidelines change in our area)

- Six is the maximum number of guests per table this includes children, inside or outside.

Closing Time

10pm CLOSED. This means all guests must leave by 9.55pm and doors closed at 10pm

Information for Test and Trace

- All details of guests are documented in our track and trace system.
- On display the official NHS QR code poster to make it easier for people to check-in. We will need to see that you have used the app or you can sign in on the good old fashioned pen and paper which we have been doing since we reopened :)
- This information is vital for the NHS Test and Trace service in England to contact the necessary people if Coronavirus outbreaks are identified in any venue.

Also;

- **There are hand sanitising stations throughout the Inn.**
- **All tables, chairs are sanitised after each use.**
- **Every hour door handles and toilet areas are sanitised.**
- **We will be adhering to the minimum of 1 metre with extra precautions and social distancing.**
- **We ask that all our guests respect social distancing whilst enjoying their visit.**

We welcome our four legged friends... but unfortunately as The Crown is a wonderful 17th century Inn we do have many small areas and pinch points also very limited tables that we can accommodate dogs. We will only allow dogs in on a lead if we you have already pre-booked your table and advising us you have a dog with you. Dogs are allowed outside the front of the building and No dogs are allowed in the back of the Inn and in the gardens.

We have unfortunately reduced staff numbers and introduced a new rota system to allow social distancing within our team; your patience will be greatly appreciated as we adjust to all of the guidelines.
